In addition to the sale, there will be pancakes & sausages for sale at 9am on the day of the sale, followed by hot dogs for lunch.

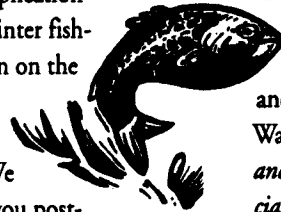
There will be space available for some new items & crafts, so interested cottagers can spend some cold winter nights crafting & collecting for the sale.
