Thanks to Tim Abbott for providing the address labels, and to Beth Abbott for assisting with the mailing (it's a big job).

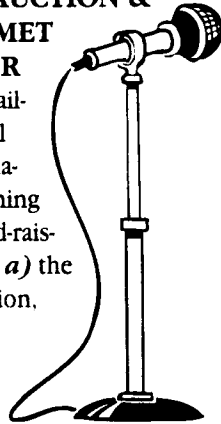
## ROADS BOARD MEETING

## THE WASTE DISPOSAL SITES

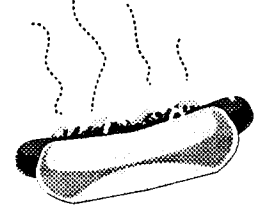
